San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("San Gabriel") hereby submits one original and four copies of the following changes in tariff sheets applicable to its Fontana Water Company Division:

### Purpose and Background

The purpose of this advice letter, submitted in accordance with Paragraph 8.5.6 of General Order No. 96-B, is to seek approval to correct a typographical error and to add the CARW Conservation Rate Service Charges not reflected in the filing of Advice Letter No. 385 to conform to the Conservation Rate Design procedures adopted in D. 10-04-031.

The typographical error relates to tariff Sheet No. 1949-W which contained an error in the ¾ inch meter Service Charge. This charge should have read \$25.18 instead of \$25.13 as submitted with Advice Letter 385. The second change included in this advice letter relates to the calculation of the two-tiered Conservation Rates for the CARW Service Charges. The Conservation Rate Design procedures adopted in D. 10-04-031, Figure 1 directed San Gabriel to calculate a division-wide traditional rate design and the resulting low-income discount in dollars. The same dollar discounts would then be applied to all CARW customers, whether on the tiered Conservation Rate or the single block General Rate.

This advice letter does not seek approval of any change in rate design or revenue requirements. **This is a Tier 1 advice letter and should become effective July 1, 2010.**

**Notice of Rate Change**

San Gabriel has already notified its customers of the proposed rate change in Application No. 08-09-008. San Gabriel has already augmented that notice through customer outreach in the form of bill inserts and postings to the company website which has alerted customers to the new two-tier conservation rates and explained how they work. No other parties have requested notification of tariff filings related to the Fontana Water Company division.
