**SERVICE CONNECTIONS, METERS, AND CUSTOMER'S FACILITIES**  
*(continued)*

D. Relocation of Service

1. When, in the judgment of the utility, the relocation of a service and/or metering facility is necessary and is due either to the maintenance of adequate service or to the operating convenience of the utility, the utility shall perform such relocation at its own expense.
  
2. When the relocation of a service and/or metering facility is necessary and is required for the convenience of customer or because of acts of the customer which render the service and/or meter location unsatisfactory to the utility, such relocation shall be performed by the utility at the sole expense of the customer.
