

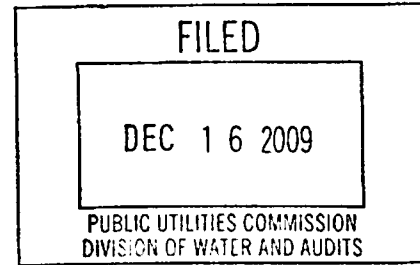

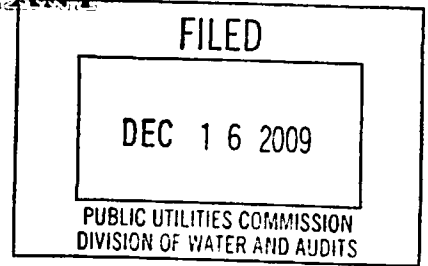

### Purpose and Background

The purpose of this advice letter, submitted in accordance with Paragraph 8.5.6 of General Order No. 96-B, is to seek approval to amend its List of Contracts and Deviations tariff sheet to reflect a change of name of a nursery served under a recycled water contract to J & E Nursery. All terms are identical to the terms of the Chuy's Nursery and its predecessor's agreements, initially approved by Commission Resolution No. W-3882, dated October 12, 1994 and later in Advice Letter 352, effective July 1, 2007.

Because this advice letter does not seek approval of any rate changes, more restrictive conditions or withdrawal of any service, a Commission resolution is not necessary to approve this filing. Advice Letter No. 379 is a Tier 2 advice letter and should become effective 30 days after the filing date.

### Notice

No individuals or utilities have requested notification of filing of tariffs. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with Sections 4.2. and 4.3 of General Order No. 96-B

### Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
