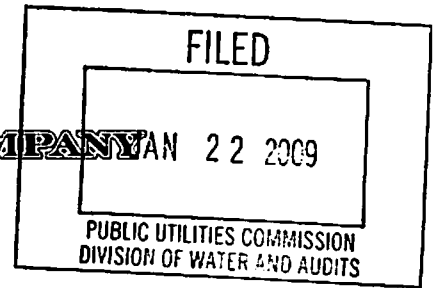

## TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("San Gabriel") hereby requests ministerial review of this Tier I advice letter for the following changes in the tariff sheets applicable to its Fontana Water Company division:

An original and four copies of this advice letter are submitted to provide clarification of the application of Facilities Fees under Schedule No. FO-FF when a customer requests an increase in meter size or in the size of a private fire service connection, consistent with Commission Decision No. 07-04-046, as modified by Decision No. 08-04-005, in Application No. 05-08-021.

### Background

Pursuant to Advice Letter No. 348 and the Commission's decision in the last general rate case for this division (D.07-04-046), San Gabriel began charging Facilities Fees under a new tariff Schedule No. FO-FF on May 21, 2007 for new metered service connections and private fire service connections and for increases in meter size or increases in the diameter of private fire service connections requested by the customer. However, the tariff schedule does not clearly specify the amount of Facilities Fees applicable to customers who request an increase in the size of their water meter or private fire service connection.

**Discussion**

San Gabriel has interpreted the Facilities Fees schedule to require customers who request a larger meter or larger diameter private fire service connection to pay the difference between the Facilities Fee applicable to the size of the existing meter or private fire service connection and the Facilities Fee applicable to the size of the requested meter or private fire service connection. Clarification of the tariff language will allow San Gabriel to continue to give effect to these fees as the Commission intended and provide applicants for the installation of larger meters or larger private fire service connections a clear explanation of the applicable charge. To implement this clarification, San Gabriel proposes to revise the language of the "Applicability" section of Schedule FO-FF, revise Special Conditions No. 1 and No. 3, and add Special Conditions No. 5 and No. 6.

No workpapers are associated with this advice letter. No further public notice is required because all public notices in connection with Application No. 05-08-021 have already been made in accordance with applicable law and Commission rules.
