## TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("San Gabriel") hereby requests review of the following changes in tariff sheets applicable to its Fontana Water Company division:

In response to Data Request SGVWC AL 431 RK 002, dated February 19, 2014, and pursuant to General Rule 7.5.1 of General Order 96-B, San Gabriel supplements Advice Letter 431 that was submitted on January 27, 2014. San Gabriel now requests only the amortization of the \$476,325.28 over-collection in the Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memorandum Account through a temporary 12-month surcredit of \$0.0294/Ccf.

An original and four copies of this supplemental advice letter are hereby submitted.

### Background

On May 1, 2012, San Gabriel filed A.12-05-002 requesting a determination of its cost of capital for the years 2013 through 2015. This application was subsequently consolidated with A.12-05-001, A.12-05-004, and A.12-05-005, and was ultimately approved by D.13-05-027.

On December 7, 2012, the Office of Ratepayer Advocates ("ORA") filed a motion for interim rates because a decision could not be issued in time for rates to become effective on

the first day of the test year (January 1, 2013). On December 18, 2012, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Rochester granted ORA's motion, as follows:

San Gabriel Valley Water Company, Park Water Company and Apple Valley Ranchos Water Company, and Suburban Water Systems shall file with the Commission, by Tier 1 Advice Letter, a tariff implementing interim rates in their respective service territories and establishing Memorandum Accounts to track the difference between the interim rate and the final rates adopted by the Commission in this proceeding. The interim rates shall become effective no sooner than January 1, 2013.

Subsequently on December 24, 2012 by e-mail and later on January 3, 2013 by a written ruling, ALJ Rochester removed the requirement that the utilities request interim rates but affirmed the requirement that applicants file advice letters to establish memorandum accounts. On December 31, 2012, San Gabriel submitted Advice Letter No. 421 to establish a Cost of Capital Interim Rates Memorandum Account ("CCIRMA"), as described in the Section N of the Preliminary Statements to the company's tariffs. Interim rates were subsequently charged for service between January 1, 2013 and May 28, 2013. The purpose of the CCIRMA is to track the difference between revenues billed under the interim rates and the revenues that would have been billed had the rates adopted by the Commission in A.12-05-002 become effective on January 1, 2013. The current balance in this account to be refunded to customers, including interest through December 31, 2013, is \$476,325.28.

The present rates in the Fontana Water Company division became effective on May 28, 2013, by Advice Letter No. 427.

### **Discussion**

Workpapers supporting the proposed surcredit have been supplied to the Commission staff for review.

In order to compute the revenue overcollection from interim rates, San Gabriel used a billing analysis generator application to determine billing based on actual customer consumption data between December 2012 and June 2013. This consumption data is processed through the billing analysis generator, initially using the current historical or base rates to generate the BILLED Results and then using the D.13-05-027 adopted rates to generate the ADOPTED Results. The differences in monthly revenues from this process were then recorded in the CCIRMA, which applied interest at the 90-day commercial paper rate to the average monthly balances.

San Gabriel proposes a 12-month surcredit of \$0.0294/Ccf, based on adopted annual metered sales of 16,184,220 Ccf. The effect of the proposed surcredit for the typical monthly bill of the average residential customer (5/8" x 3/4" meter and 19 Ccf) is a reduction of \$0.56 or 0.9% from \$60.26 to \$59.70.

Distribution of this supplemental advice letter is being made to the attached service list in accordance with Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order 96-B, and San Gabriel will post this advice letter to its website in accordance with Water Industry Rule 3.3. No further public notice is required.

3. The utility will supply only such recycled water at such pressure as may be available from time to time from the recycled water system. The customer shall indemnify the utility and save it harmless against any and all claims arising out of service under this schedule and shall further agree to make no claims against the utility for any loss or damage resulting from service under this schedule.

2. Application and Eligibility Declaration: An application and eligibility declaration on a form authorized by the Commission is required for each request for service under this schedule. Renewal of a customer's eligibility declaration will be required every two years and may be required on an annual basis. Customers are only eligible to receive service under this rate schedule at one residential location at any one time, and the rate applies only to the customer's permanent primary residence. The schedule is not applicable where, in the opinion of the Utility, either the accomodation or the occupancy is transitory.
3. Commencement of Rate: Eligible customers shall be billed on this schedule commencing no later than one billing period after receipt and approval of the customer's application by the Utility.
4. Verification: Information provided by the applicant is subject to verification by the Utility. Refusal or failure of a customer to provide documentation of eligibility acceptable to the Utility, upon the request of the Utility, shall result in removal from this rate schedule.
5. Notice from Customer: It is the customer's responsibility to notify the Utility if there is a change in the customer's eligibility status.
6. Customers may be re-billed for periods of ineligibility under the applicable rate schedule.
7. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth on Schedule No. AA-UF.
8. A rate adjustment of \$0.0298 per Ccf for the adopted increase revenue requirements associated with the General Division is to be added to the quantity rates beginning November 15, 2011 and ending on the effective date of the rates from Application 11-07-005.
9. A surcredit of \$0.46 per Ccf is to be applied to the quantity rates for twenty-months beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 420 and ending on June 30, 2014 to refund an overcollection in the Water Production Balancing Account.
10. A surcredit of \$0.0294 per Ccf is to be applied to the quantity rates for a 12-month period beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 431-A to amortize the overcollection in the Cost of Capital Interim Rate Memorandum Account. (CCIRMA). (N)
