San Gabriel Valley Water Company ("San Gabriel") hereby requests review and approval of the following changes in tariff sheets applicable to its Fontana Water Company division:

An original and four copies of this advice letter are submitted to request authorization to transfer the October 2017 undercollection of \$1,122,777 tracked in the Interim Rates Memorandum Account (IRMA) to the Previously Authorized Balances Balancing Account (PABBA) and to simultaneously close the IRMA. Per Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of Commission Resolution W-5043, **this advice letter is designated as Tier 2.**

Discussion

By Advice Letter 457, effective February 13, 2015, San Gabriel instituted a \$0.1440 per Ccf surcharge in the Fontana Water Company division to amortize the January 2015 undercollected balance in the IRMA. That surcharge expired on September 12, 2017, leaving an uncollected balance of \$1,122,777, as of October 2017. Because only accrued interest may be recorded in this memorandum account in the future, San Gabriel proposes

to close this memorandum account and to transfer the residual balance to the PABBA. No rate changes are proposed in this advice letter.

Workpapers supporting the 2015-2017 entries to the IRMA have been submitted to Commission staff for its review and verification.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) San Gabriel did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which San Gabriel relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Water Division, within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
