An original and four copies of this advice letter are submitted herewith. San Gabriel submits this advice letter in compliance with D.16-03-021 in A.15-08-022 to transfer recovery of the forecasted costs of the California Alternative Rates for Water ("CARW") program for the Los Angeles County Division from the Monthly Service Charges (which are being decreased by \$881,652 annually) to a \$0.1851/Ccf CARW surcharge on its non-

CARW customers only, and to update the CARW participation rates in both divisions to reflect current participation levels, increasing the CARW Surcharge in the Fontana Water Company division from \$0.1297/Ccf to \$0.2408/Ccf on non-CARW customers only. This compliance advice letter is designated as a Tier 1 and becomes effective immediately upon submittal.

Background

On August 24, 2015, San Gabriel filed Application No. 15-08-022 requesting authority to modify its CARW rate design in its Los Angeles County division to mirror the adopted CARW rate design in its Fontana Water Company division. Also, due to substantial monthly entries into its CARW balancing accounts, San Gabriel sought to increase its recovery of CARW expenses based on current levels of CARW participation. The application was not opposed and evidentiary hearings were not held. On March 17, 2016, the Commission issued D.16-03-021, granting the requested authorizations. The relevant Ordering Paragraphs are as follows:

1. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to increase the surcharge on non-California Alternative Rates for Water customers in its Fontana Water Company Division from \$0.1297 per 100 cubic feet (Ccf) to \$0.2408 per Ccf.
2. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to increase the surcharge on non-California Alternative Rates for Water customers in its Los Angeles Division from \$0.1308 per 100 cubic feet (Ccf) to \$0.1851 per Ccf.
3. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to change the rate design of benefits to California Alternative Rates for Water customers in its Los Angeles Division from a 50 percent discount on monthly service charges, to a flat dollar amount based upon the size of the customer's meter. The flat rate for a customer with a 5/8" x 3/4" meter shall be \$8.00 per month. The flat rate for a customer with a 3/4" meter shall be \$10.00 per month. The flat rate for a customer with a 1" meter shall be \$20.00 per month.

4. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to exclude recovery of \$881,652 of California Alternative Rates for Water benefits from its monthly service charge revenue.
5. Within five days of the effective date of this decision, San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized to file a Tier 1 Advice Letter with revised tariff schedules incorporating the new surcharges in its Fontana and Los Angeles Division. The filing shall be subject to approval by the Commission's Division of Water and Audits.

Notice of Advice Letter Filing

Notice was provided at the time the application was filed. No further notice is required. Distribution of this advice letter is being made to the attached service lists in accordance with Water Industry Rule 4.1 of General Order No. 96-B.

Protest and Responses

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) San Gabriel did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly

consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:

1. The customer will pay, without refund, the entire cost of the private fire service facilities.
2. The private fire service facilities shall be installed by the utility or under the utility's direction and shall be the sole property and subject to the control of the utility, with the right to alter, repair, replace and the right to remove upon discontinuance of service.
3. The minimum diameter for the private fire service connection will be 4 inches. The maximum diameter shall not be larger than the diameter of the water main to which the private fire service facilities are attached unless said main is circulating, in which case with the approval of the utility the maximum diameter may be larger by not more than 2 inches than the diameter of said circulating main.
4. If a water main of adequate size is not available adjacent to the premises to be served, then a new main from the nearest existing main of adequate size will be installed by the utility at the cost of the customer. Such cost shall not be subject to refund.
5. The private fire service facilities will include a detector check valve or other similar device acceptable to the utility which will indicate the use of water. The facilities may be located within the customer's premises or within public right of way adjacent thereto. Where located within the premises, the utility and its duly authorized agents shall have the right of ingress to and egress from the premises for all purposes related to said facilities. In the event the installation is solely a private fire hydrant facility, the requirement for a detector check valve or other similar device may be waived.

The schedule is not applicable where, in the opinion of the Utility, either the accomodation or the occupancy is transitory.
3. **Commencement of Rate:** Eligible customers shall be billed on this schedule commencing no later than one billing period after receipt and approval of the customer's application by the Utility.
